About the Role

The Wash Plant Utility role is a field operations position responsible for supporting wet plant production through housekeeping, equipment monitoring, sampling, and general plant support tasks. This is an entry-level to mid-level production role ideal for candidates who want to build a career in frac sand processing.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform routine equipment walkarounds and report abnormal conditions to the supervisor or CRO
- Collect in-process and feed samples for QC testing as directed
- Perform housekeeping duties including wash-down of screens, cyclone areas, conveyors, and sumps
- Clear plugged chutes, screens, and equipment as directed and following lockout/tagout procedures
- Assist with conveyor belt tracking, screen panel changes, and general plant maintenance support
- Monitor sump levels, pump operation, and water balance areas during rounds
- Support supervisor and CRO with manual adjustments and process support tasks
- Participate in pre-shift safety meetings and toolbox talks
- Follow all MSHA Part 46 safety requirements

Qualifications

- Prior experience in an industrial, mining, or processing environment preferred but not required — we will train the right candidate
- Ability to perform physical work in outdoor/industrial conditions including heat, dust, and noise
- Safety-conscious mindset and willingness to follow established procedures
- Reliable and punctual with ability to work rotating shifts including nights and weekends
- MSHA Part 46 training or willingness to complete upon hire
